SUPPORT FOR ARTS AND CULTURE EDUCATION ACT_(ENACTMENT IN 2005)

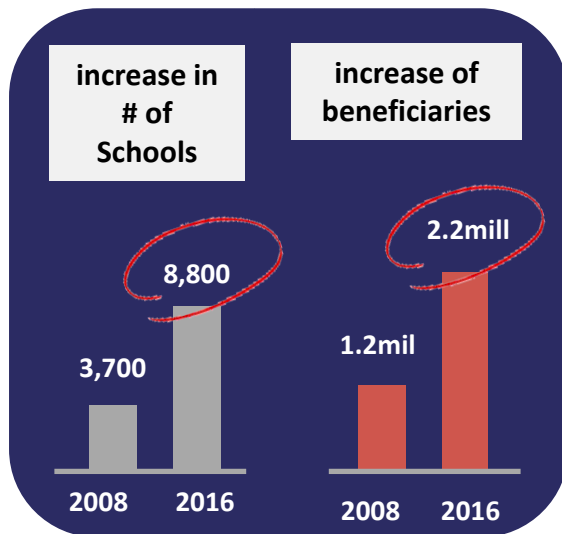
Article 1 (Purpose) The purpose of this Act is to vitalize arts and culture education, moreover to contribute towards the improvement in quality of cultural lives of the people and to strengthen the cultural capability of the State by identifying items necessary for the support of arts and culture education.

Article 3 (Basic Principles of Arts and Culture Education)

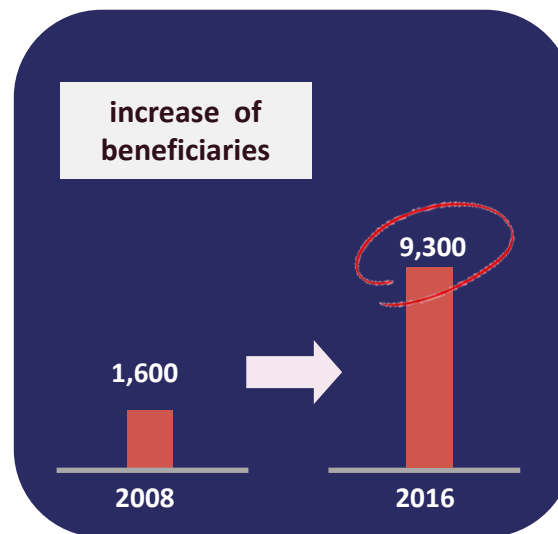
- ① Arts and culture education shall aim at education through which all citizens can enjoy arts and culture and develop creativity.
- ② All citizens are guaranteed with equal opportunities to systematically study and receive education on arts and culture throughout their lives according to their interests and aptitudes regardless of age, gender, disability, social status, economic circumstances, place of residence, etc.

Expansion of Arts Education Policy

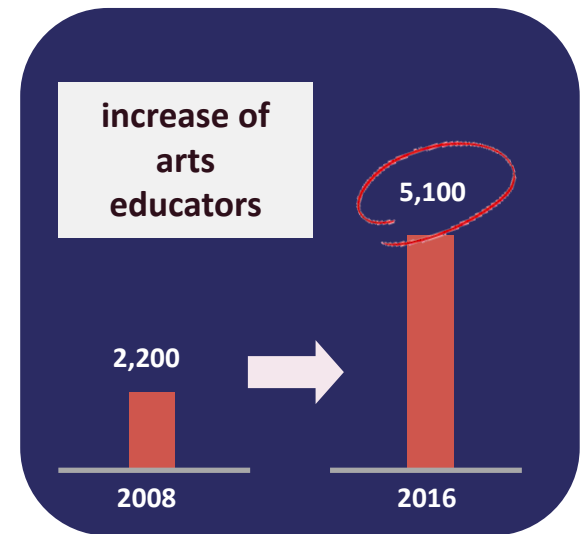

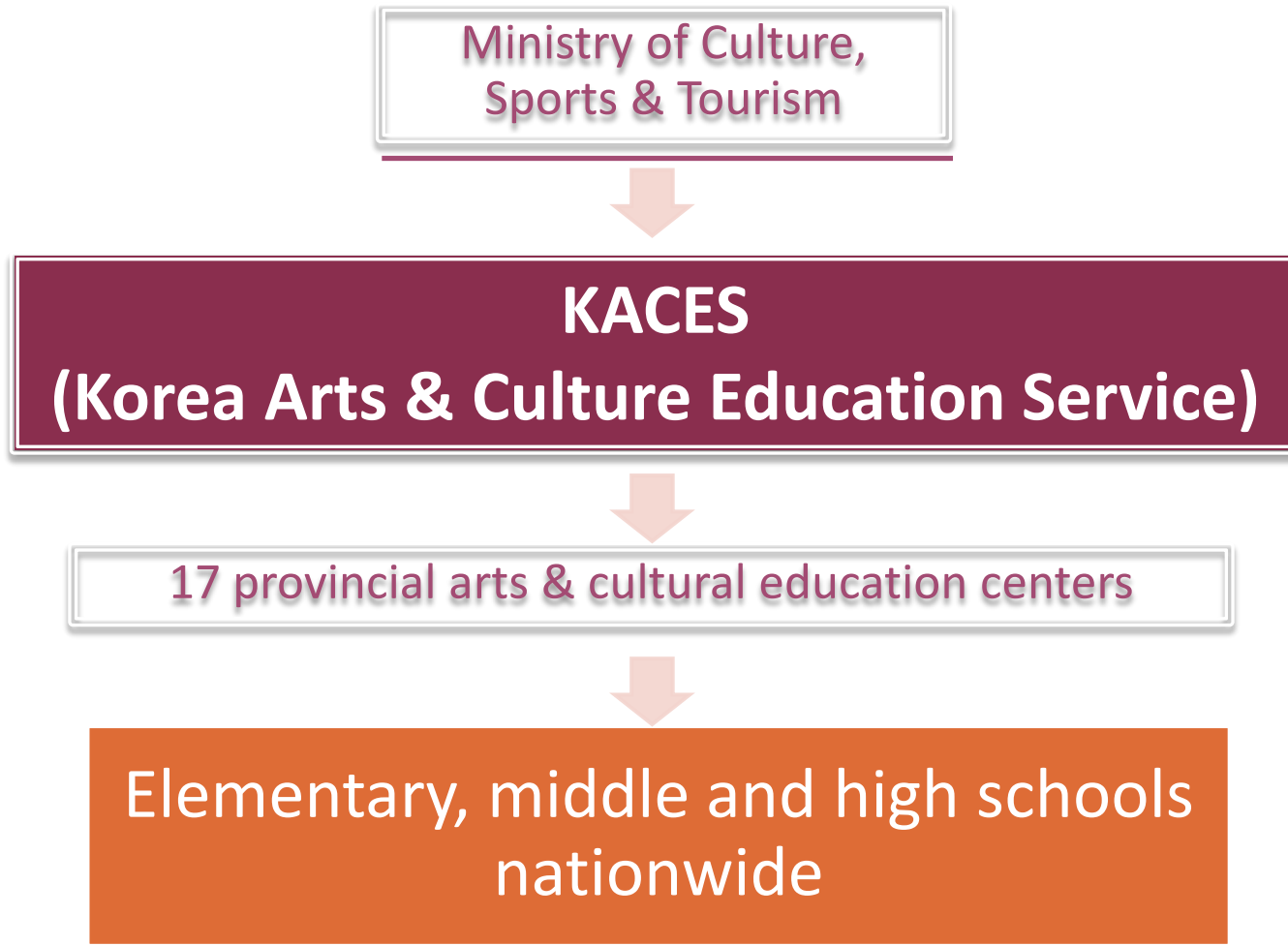

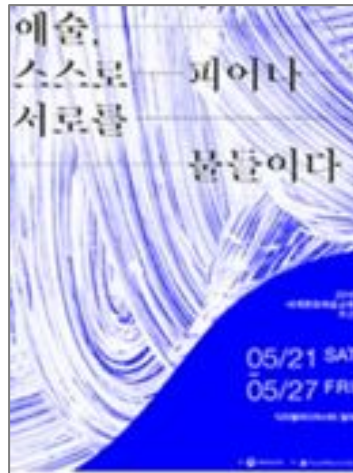

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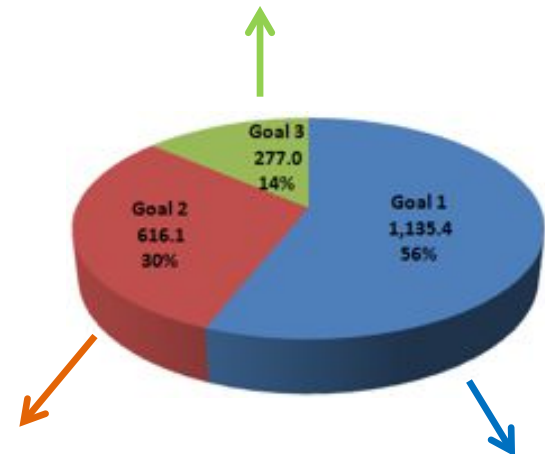
